Daniel Larocque, PhD

Project Leader, R&D Innovation and CD Laval, GSK Vaccines

Dr Daniel Larocque is presently a project leader at GlaxoSmithKline Vaccines located in Laval here in Quebec as well as in Rixensart, Belgium. He joined GSK in 2007 as expert scientist working on vaccines adjuvant discovery. Then, he has led the chronic disorder immunotherapy program working on Alzheimer's vaccine until clinical trial.

Since 2 years, Daniel is the project leader on Innovations to design future adjuvanted vaccine portfolio. He has been prolific in term of new collaboration setup, publications and patents and innovation project at GSK. He is the inventor of 6 patents since 2007.

Before joining GSK, Daniel has been postdoctoral fellow at UCLA and Cedars-Sinai Medical Center working for Dr Pedro Lowenstein in Los Angeles for 4 years. He did his PhD at McGill University in Experimental Medicine working for Dr Stéphane Richard and collaborating with Dr Sam David.
