The EWCBR Organizing Committee has the pleasure to inform you that our **Conference 2017** will take place in **ARC 1800, FRANCE**.

The **Golf Hotel\*\*\***, built by Le Corbusier, is right on the slopes of the legendary Les Arcs resort, with stunning views of the mountains. Outdoor swimming-pool and SPA.

The Scientific Committee, as in previous years, invites participants to organize scientific sessions on a particular theme of their interest.

We anticipate that the program be as wide as possible, from molecular neurobiology to clinical neurology, including electrophysiology, pharmacology, physiology, cognition, anatomy, pathology, behaviour, genetics, functional imagery, etc. **the underlying priority of this conference being "interdisciplinary communication"**.

Each organizer of a scientific session will have the possibility of **inviting in his session one junior scientist at a reduced registration rate (50 €)**.

Already **accepted sessions** are on addiction, epilepsy, inflammation, disease avoidance, reward etc.

The **plenary lecture** will be given by **Gustavo Deco** on **"Linking structure and function: Lessons from Neuroimaging and Whole-Brain Modelling"**

The **second cycle of submission** starts now. A title, a short summary explaining the interest of the session, and the participants' names and addresses should be submitted to [Christophe.bernard@univ-amu.fr](mailto:Christophe.bernard@univ-amu.fr) or to [christelle.baunez@univ-amu.fr](mailto:christelle.baunez@univ-amu.fr) before **DECEMBER 15<sup>th</sup> , 2016**. Alternatively, you can try to fit in one of the already accepted sessions (please contact us). You can also submit an abstract.

The Organizing Committee's acceptance decision will be given before the end of **DECEMBER 2016**.

Each session organizer must provide written acceptance of participation from all potential participants before final acceptance can be given.
